BASIS AND PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

Your personal data will be processed only for the purpose of organizing and implementing a professional/ summer/ graduate internship.

The basis for the processing of your personal data is art. 6 section 1 point b) General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

INFORMATION ON REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE DATA

Providing the data is necessary and results from the provisions of law, i.e. the Act on Higher Education / Regulation of the Ministry of National Education on practical vocational training / Act on graduate apprenticeships. If the data is not provided, it is impossible to organize and implement a professional/ summer / graduate internship.

SHARED DATA

The data may be available to entities or bodies authorized under the provisions of law, as well as on the basis of data entrustment agreements.

DATA STORAGE PERIOD

Your personal data will be stored for the duration of your professional/ summer / graduate internship, and then, in accordance with law on archiving documentation – 5 years from the end of the above- mentioned internship.

RIGHTS RELATED TO DATA PROCESSING

You have the right, on the terms set out in GDPR, to:

- a. To demand the access to your personal data from administrator
- b. Demand their rectification
- c. Request their removal, unless applicable law requires the storage of data,
- d. Request to limit their processing,
- e. Object to processing
- f. Data portability
- g. Withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing, which was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal, except for situations where the need for further data processing result from the obligations specified by law,
- h. File a complaint to the supervisory body, i.e. to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, if you deem it justified that the personal data is processed contrary to the General Data Protection Regulation.

Your personal data is not subject to automated decision making in this profiling.

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

1. A student, as a person preparing to perform a medical profession, is entitled to access to medical documentation, pursuant to Art. 26 sec. 3a of the Act of November 6, 2008 about the rights of the Patient and Patient Ombudsman (Journal of Laws 2020.849).
2. Medical documentation to be used for teaching/clinical purposes shall be made available without disclosing the surname and other data enabling the identification of the person to whom the documentation is related.
3. Student can get access to the medical records:
 - only to the extent necessary to achieve the didactic/clinical goals,
 - provided that the information contained therein is kept secret.
4. Access to medical records is supervised by the medical Staff taking care of the students.

In connection with the permission to process personal data, I declare that:

- I have read and undertake to comply with the obligations arising from:
 - Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of the personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (general regulation on data protection) – hereinafter referred to as the GDPR.
